Founded in 1988 to address the HIV epidemic, Harlem United is now a full-service community healthcare center that provides healthcare, housing, prevention, and supportive services to those most in need in New York City. Our clients come from communities of color facing extreme poverty, homelessness, chronic health issues, and systemic barriers to access.

Annually, Harlem United provides dignified housing for almost 1,000 formerly homeless people, conducts more than 23,000 medical visits, engages over 10,000 people across all our programs, and provides in excess of 20,000 hot meals and pantry bags to those in need. Harlem United operates with a total annual revenue of approximately \$51 million and a staff of 320+ employees. Our roots are planted in the community and together, we build a healthier future.

Across our diverse programming, we offer client- and patient-centered care without stigma or judgment to clients grappling with multiple chronic conditions, homelessness and extreme poverty. We are guided by a harm reduction philosophy that encourages any positive behavioral change in our clients, moving towards more independence and wellness.

Care for Chronic Conditions

Through our NYSDOH Article 28 Diagnostic and Treatment Center and our NYS OMH Article 31 licenses, our Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) in Harlem helps patients to access culturally-affirmative and non-judgmental care. We offer wrap-around, co-located services to people living with HIV/AIDS and other chronic conditions, such as substance use disorder or serious mental illness.
