Founded in 1988 to address the HIV epidemic, Harlem United is now a full-service community healthcare center that provides healthcare, housing, prevention, and supportive services to those most in need in New York City. Our clients come from communities of color, facing extreme poverty, homelessness, chronic health issues, and systemic barriers to access.

Annually, Harlem United provides dignified housing for more than 1,000 formerly homeless people, conducts more than 24,000 medical visits, engages over 9,000 people across all our programs, and provides in excess of 15,000 hot meals and pantry bags to those in need. Harlem United operates with a total annual revenue of approximately \$50 million and a staff of almost 300 employees. Our roots are planted in the community and together, we build a healthier future.


